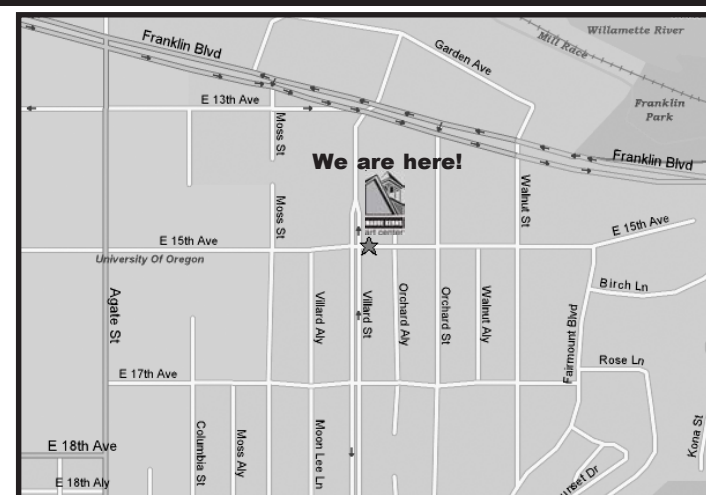
Artist Lecture: Ever Picture Tells A Story
