Recognized for his expressive painting style and masterful use of color, Sarkis believes that "A picture is better than 1,000 words." In keeping with this painting philosophy, Sarkis's five-day workshop will teach you how to complete a painting from beginning to end. You will explore a variety of subjects including figures, landscapes, and still lifes as you experiment with paint application, composition, and color.

Over the course of this workshop, Sarkis will customize a curriculum to suit the skills and interests of you and your fellow students. He will guide you through the process of painting and offer his assistance and inspiration.

Sarkis will begin each day with a painting demonstration in which he will complete a painting from start to finish, enabling you to observe his techniques and ask questions. You will then begin work on your painting, putting into practice the skills and techniques Sarkis has demonstrated. Individual and group critiques will also help to strengthen your paintings. Students will have a lunch break on each day. \$100 Deposit is required at the time of registration.
