



## **An Introduction to Ink Drawing**

You are welcome to purchase new materials for this class, but please feel free to bring any materials you may already have on-hand, especially if you are on a budget.

### **Materials List:**

- 1 HB Tombow mono pencil
- 1 Pad of 9" x 12" Bristol paper Vellum Surface.
- 2 sheets of 22" x 30" Fabriano Cold Press Watercolor paper 140 lb (each sheet should be cut in half)
- 1 or more Ampersand Scratchboard 8" x 10"
- 2 or more Ampersand Clayboard 8" x 10"
- 1 Xacto knife #1
- Sakura Micron Pens; 1 or more of sizes 005, 02, and 08.
- Speedball Caligraphy dip pen set #5; Artists Set (includes 2 nib holders and 5 nibs)
- Speedball Scratch Knife nib (no. 112 or no. 113)
- 1 bottle of waterproof India ink ('Winsor & Newton', 'Dr. PH martin', or 'Bombay' are good brands)
- 1 small or medium bottle of Yasutomo brand Sumi ink
- 1 small bottle of walnut drawing ink
- 1 2" wide Hake brush
- 1 large (size 6) Yasutomo bamboo Sumi brush

Parking is available in the lot on the east side of the building. If the lot is full, parking passes are available in the front office. Enter through the glass doors around the back and up the ramp.



- 1 Winsor&Newton Cotman round watercolor brush #1
- 1 black Pentel Color Brush pen size medium or fine
- 4 small Glass or plastic cups/jars for water and ink solutions

For purchasing your materials locally both Oregon Art Supply and the University Bookstore will have what you need. At Oregon Art Supply, if you bring your materials list with you, you will receive a 20% discount for being a student.
