ELIGIBLE WORK

Eligible work: Entries in 2D and 3D collage in all media will be considered, including drawing, painting, digital, printmaking, textile, photography, mixed media, sculpture, as well as any other forms of assemblage and material. Applicants can submit up to three artworks.

Apply by Mail

Submit digital images on a flash drive (JPEG format–300 dpi resolution). Flash drives must be marked clearly and legibly with the artist’s name and individual images should be labeled with the title of the work.

A \$20 submission fee must be enclosed with application. Checks should be made payable to Maude Kerns Art Center. Cash or credit payment must be made in person if turning in the application at the office. ***Mailed submissions must be postmarked by May 2 and will not be returned.***
