Materials List

Pastels

There are many brands to choose from- A large variety of colors is preferred

Please No oil pastels - We are focusing on soft pastel painting.

Ordering or Purchasing Locally - Pastels are available in limited quantities at ••

What pastels to get:

- Hard- Nupastels
- Medium- Rembrandt
- Soft- Unison, Sennelier, Schmincke
- Student grade pastels to be avoided

Papers and Other Supports

- Sanded papers are recommended. Pastel papers not recommended for final work
- If you can afford it, get a variety of colors- middle value -50%- best. Warm (reds and oranges & cool colors too)
- White is the least desirable color

Brand of Papers I like

- Canson Mi Tintes papers in dark colors very good to start with (brick reds)
- Art Spectrum Sanded Papers
- Avoid Amersand, Sennelier and Wallis because they do not work well for wet painting

Best, sizes

9x12 & 20x 28 (you can cut this paper in half)

Other Supplies

- 9x12 #600 grit wet/dry sand paper from hardware stores- good for sketches
- Drawing Board- To clip a few sheets of pastel paper on
- notebook- for class notes
- Sketchbook
- Thick black marker, pencils
- A cloth rag
