Class: Beginning Oil Painting

### Paint

- 1- Alizarin Crimson
- 1- Hansa Yellow
- 1- Ultramarine Blue
- 1- Burnt Umber
- 1- Titanium White
- Approximately 1.25 fl oz or more
- No need to purchase large tubes at this time
- Student-grade like Daler-Rowney Georgian

### Palette

- 1- ceramic dish (approximately 12" square or diameter; or larger)
- You can find these items at Bring Recycle or a thrift store
- Dishes not to be used for eating
- OR-
- 1- 12 x 12" or larger glass panel (edges duct taped for safety) \*Glass pallets are best and easier to scrap clean

### Palette Knives

- 1- Diamond shape head
- Can be plastic or metal w/wooden handle
- #12-14 size (sizes are usually on metal/wood supplies)

### Brushes (oil; usually long-handled)

- 1- Flat #8
- 1- Flat #4
- 1- Round #8
- 1- Round #4
- 1- Round #2 or #3 (for detail)

### Canvas Board

- 4 to 6 - 11 x 14 (to start) 2- 16 x 20 (possibly)
- Let's start with the 11 x 14
- Around week 4 or 5, we can discuss the 16 x 20 painting surface

### Cotton Rags

Supply Case or Tote for storage of supplies and materials

Small glass jar w/ lid

Container for soiled rags

\*\*This is a beginning class so inexpensive student-grade supplies will work just fine. \*\*\*Feel free to bring in your own personal supplies as well.
