Beading and Jewelry making materials

- Bring or buy your own beads. **Please DO NOT bring seed beads and pearls!** These items are too small for typical beading wire and pearls, in particular, often need additional reaming that will be not possible in this class. We will go over more of the types of useful items on the first day of class.

You are encouraged to purchase what you like for the class in advance. You may wish to checkout MECCA or Harlequin for additional beads after the first day of class. We recognize that this isn't a lot of time to shop before the second day, but remember that you will take these skills with you to start making more designs in the future.

- One 30" roll of 19-strand satin silver Beadalon
- Optional jewelry tools: While Bea will have most of the hand tools available for us to share, some of you may be ready to purchase your own to continue designing once the workshop is over. If that is the case, here is the list of tools you will need:
 - Pliers
 - Crimpers
 - Cutters
 - Tweezers
